Job Summary: As a member of the CSCT Treatment Team, Behavioral Specialist will be expected to provide behavioral management and support services to seriously emotionally disturbed youth in a school based setting i.e., classroom, school grounds, during educational and recreational activities. Behavioral Specialist works under the direct supervision of the CSCT program therapist, assisting team members in providing a safe, structured, and nurturing environment.

Essential Job Responsibilities: Assess SED student behaviors in all program areas and implement behavior management interventions according to treatment plan and/or under direction from CSCT Therapist. Assist CSCT Therapist in intervention in student crisis situations. Communicate and collaborate with treatment team, CSCT program and school staff. Attend program staff meetings and school meetings as necessary. Participate in team meetings, including school meetings as necessary. Document behavioral management interactions with SED students according to CSCT program guidelines, including individual and group contact notes, Quarterly Reports, and Incident Reports. Organize and implement individual, group and recreational activities in collaboration with the treatment team and/or under the direction of CSCT Therapist. Participate in on-going program development. Consult with CSCT student families according to program guidelines. Oversee maintenance of program areas.

Qualifications: Ability to work with children struggling with serious mental health issues.

Education & Experience: BA in Human Services or a related field. Experience working with SED youth and families. Treatment team experience preferred. Strong behavioral management skills required.
