Hours: All shifts available. Several openings available to provide coverage when census changes. Must have flexibility to meet shift needs.

Job Summary: Under general supervision provide crisis stabilization services to individuals with mental health crises and residents in need of 24-hour care. Assist in assessment and planning for services for clients admitted during shift. Implement treatment plan provided. Provide timely and detailed documentation of client status and services provided. Assure safety of clients and co-workers. Provide direct care and supportive counseling. Perform chores such as cleaning, meal preparation and client transport.

Qualifications: Effective communication skills (oral and written) and ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with clients, families, co-workers and others in the community. Ability to exercise professional judgment in evaluating situations and making decisions. Effectively apply required technical knowledge regarding mental illness and crisis intervention.

Education, Experience & Other Requirements: The above knowledge, skills and abilities are typically acquired through an Associate of Arts degree and 1 year work experience in a mental health setting. Equivalent combinations of education and experience may be considered. Must have or ability to obtain valid Montana Driver's License with good background and pass background check.
