**Job Summary:** Responsible for providing clinical counseling services to adult and youth clients at Western Montana Mental Health Center.

**Essential Job Responsibilities:** Provide clinical assessment and intake; group, individual, youth, couples, and family therapy sessions; emergency evaluation and management; diagnosis; and case management. Utilize Partners for Change Outcome Management System (PCOMS) into daily work with clients. Must adhere to policies and procedures including productivity and case load expectations, treatment planning and ethical and confidentiality expectations. Must work effectively under stressful conditions; assess and manage numerous severe mental health cases; address one's own mental health needs and model a mentally healthy lifestyle; effectively manage time and schedules; work closely with other members of a treatment team and other community agencies; develop, implement and evaluate service plans and communicate effectively orally and in writing; and additional responsibilities as needed or assigned.

**Education & Experience:** This position requires a graduate degree from an accredited institution in psychology, clinical social work, professional counseling, or other clinical behavioral science. License eligible within two years of hire is required, a professional Montana license (LCSW/LCPC) preferred. Community mental health and/or psychiatric hospital experience is preferred.
