Job Summary: As a member of the treatment team, provide services for emotionally disturbed youth in a school treatment program. Monitor behaviors in the classroom, during activities, and on the school grounds. Lead and/or assist in groups, assist in therapy sessions and behavior interventions as directed by the treatment team. Assist the team in providing a safe, structured, nurturing environment.

Essential Job Responsibilities:

1. Monitor student behaviors in all program areas and implement interventions according to treatment plan and/or direction from Therapist/Program Coordinator.
2. Assist Therapist/Program Coordinator in crisis situations.
3. Attend program staff meetings and school meetings as necessary.
4. Participate in team meetings, including IEP/CST meetings as necessary.
5. Document interactions with students and groups according to program guidelines, including group notes, Monthly Progress Reports, Incident Reports and Daily Tracking sheet.
6. Organize and implement group and recreation activities in collaboration with the treatment team and/or direction from Therapist/Program Coordinator.
7. Participate in contact with student families according to program guidelines.

Qualifications: Effective verbal and written communications. Ability to communicate and collaborate with the treatment team, program and school staff. Need to have computer skills using word processing, e-mail and internet.

Education & Experience: BA in social science or related field and 2 years experience working with emotionally disturbed youth.
