Hours: Five 8 hour days with some on-call duties, as well as one weekend about every 10 weeks.

Job Summary: This member of the PACT multidisciplinary team has training in social work, psychology or education and clinical skill and experience to assess, plan, develop, coordinate, and provide treatment, rehabilitation, and support services to program clients with severe and disabling mental illnesses under the clinical supervision of the team leader and the APRN. Functions as a clinical member of the multidisciplinary team and provides treatment rehabilitation and support services.

Essential Job Responsibilities: Provide care coordinator services for PACT team clients. Provide care coordinator services for assigned clients. Involvement in multidisciplinary team to develop treatment plan for client's involved in PACT services.

Qualifications: The candidates will demonstrate ability to interact professionally within the community and make referrals. Candidates will demonstrate the ability to prioritize and to respond appropriately to simultaneous demands. Candidates will demonstrate the ability to work as a team member on a team of professionals that is aimed at offering the least restrictive interventions for individuals diagnosed with SDMI.

Education & Experience: The above knowledge and abilities are typically acquired through a combination of education and experience equivalent to a Bachelor's degree in Social Work or a related field and preferably one (1) year progressively responsible experience in a community mental health center or similar setting.
